

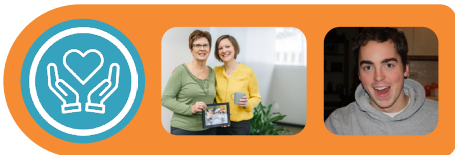
Envisioning a world without blindness

Changing lives through the healing power of donation, transplantation and research

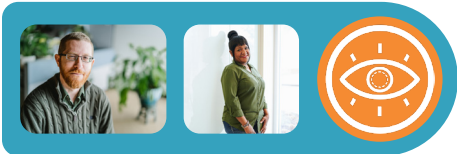
Corneal blindness affects 12 million people around the world. Eversight and our many dedicated partners are working to address this global burden and help make vision a reality for more people around the world.

8,562 donors and their families gave the precious gift of sight for transplantation, research and education.



4,723 tissues opened new frontiers in research, education & clinical training, paving the way for future breakthroughs in preventing, treating and curing blinding eye conditions.



Their generosity resulted in **14,927** gifts of healing provided for transplantation, research and education.



10,204 tissues restored sight to people in need worldwide.



Eversight facilitated **343** training and education sessions to **918** surgeons, fellows, residents, coordinators, eye bankers and other clinicians, so they can restore sight to more people throughout their careers.



76 tissues, provided through our global aid program, extended the gift of sight to underserved communities worldwide.

We worked with surgeons in **34 countries** to provide the gift of sight to those in need.
